

**ST. CHRISTOPHER SCHOOL NEW REGISTRATION
2010 – 2011 SCHOOL YEAR**

Registration for all **new students in grades K – 8** will begin on **March 15, 2010**. If you are registering a student for grades 1 – 8, please call the school office at 898-5104 to check the availability of space in particular grades.

Registration materials for new students can be obtained from the school office between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. All registration forms for students in grades 1 – 8 must be accompanied by a **\$100.00 per student non-refundable registration fee**. This covers the cost of Religion textbooks, Student Agenda Books, and various other consumables used throughout the year.

If you are registering a child for **kindergarten**, you will need to bring copies of your child's birth certificate, immunization record and baptismal certificate. State law requires that your child be five years old by September 30, 2010. Registration materials for new kindergarten students must be accompanied by a **\$100.00 non-refundable registration fee**. The fee covers the cost of the Religion textbooks and other consumable supplies used throughout the year.

For parents of children entering **Kindergarten**, the **orientation meeting will be held on April 20th**. This informational meeting will be given by our school psychologist, Mr. Pat Maloney, our kindergarten teacher, Mrs. Chiappone, and our School Principal, Sr. Pat. It will be held in the multi-purpose room and will begin at **6:30 p.m.** It is at this meeting that parents will be able to sign up for a **KINDERGARTEN SCREENING TIME. SCREENING WILL BE HELD ON APRIL 23rd**, BEGINNING AT APPROXIMATELY 9:00 A.M. Transportation sign up sheets will be available for all kindergarten students who will be riding the Vandalia-Butler, Tipp City, Northridge, and Northmont public school buses. Car riders and daycare students will also need to be signed up at this time.

Acceptance into the St. Christopher Kindergarten Program is determined by the child's readiness which is based on age and screening results.
